How can you be a person of good character?


- Virtues are considered characteristics of high standards that lead to individual greatness.

Aristotle was a Greek Philosopher who was responsible for major contributions to society.

He said there were two types of virtues:

- ♣ Intellectual Virtues: Acquired by education
- Moral Virtues: Acquired through practice and habit

"Courage is the most important of all the virtues because without courage, you can't practice any other virtue consistently."

Maya Angelou was an American poet, singer, memoirist, and civil rights activist.

She published seven autobiographies, three books of essays, several books of poetry, and is credited with a list of plays, movies, and television shows spanning over 50 years.

She received dozens of awards and more than 50 honorary degrees.

Angelou is best known for her series of seven autobiographies, which focus on her childhood and early adult experiences.

The first, <u>I Know Why the Caged Bird Sings</u> (1969), tells of her life up to the age of 17 and brought her international recognition and acclaim.
